



Fitting Instructions for RAD0156BK Radiator Guard
SUZUKI V-STROM 1000 '06 – '13



In This Kit There Should Be

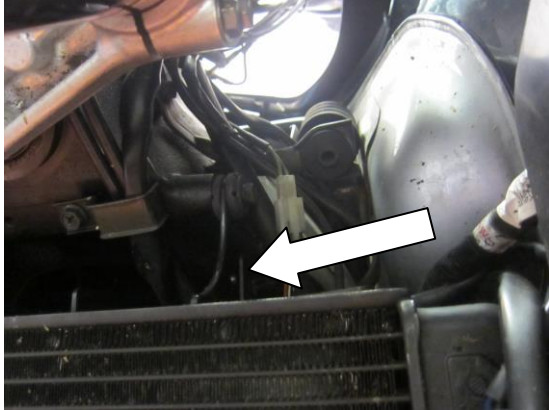
- 1x Radiator Guard (RAD0156BK)**
- 2x M6 x 16mm Long Button Head Bolts**
- 2x M6 Washers**
- 2x M6 Nyloc Nuts**
- 2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam**

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 4mm A/F & 10mm socket & wrench.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Remove the bolt that secures the bottom of the radiator in place, as shown in picture 1.
- Take the two M6 x 16mm bolts, washers and nyloc nuts supplied in the kit and lay them out on a workbench as shown in picture 2. *There are two holes in the bracket attached to the top of the radiator which mount it to the frame which these bolts will need to go through (the left hand side bracket/hole is arrowed in picture 3).*
- Offer the R&G Radiator Guard into place on the bike, ensuring that the two upper mounting tabs sit on the outside of the upper radiator mounting brackets, as shown in picture 4. Fit the two M6 x 16mm bolts, washers and nuts through the radiator guard mounting hole and then through the hole in the radiator mount bracket, also shown in picture 4, before tightening

- With the radiator guard in place, the lower bracket should align with the lower radiator mount, as shown in picture 5. Re-fit the original bolt and tighten.
- Ensure the radiator guard is correctly mounted and tighten all bolts evenly.

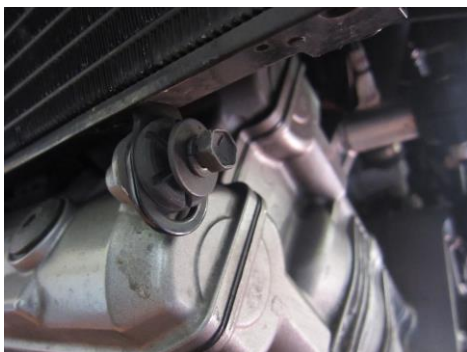

OUTILS REQUIS

- Jeu de clés 4mm et douille 10mm.

Instructions de montage:

- Couper la mousse en bandeaux de 10mm puis collez ces bandeaux au bas du support de protection radiateur, de façon à ce que ces bandeaux se situent entre la protection radiateur et le radiateur.
- Enlever le boulon qui fixe le bas du radiateur en place (Photo 1).
- Prendre les 2 boulons M6 x 16mm, rondelles et écrous fournis dans le kit et disposez les sur un établi (Photo 2). *Il y a 2 trous dans le support fixé au niveau du haut du radiateur qui le fixe au cadre et dont les boulons devront passer à travers (le support coté gauche/trou est fléché sur la Photo 3).*
- Mettre la grille en position sur la moto, en veillant à ce que les 2 pattes de fixation soient placées sur le coté extérieur des supports de fixation supérieurs du radiateur (Photo 4). Insérez les 2 boulons M6 x 16mm, rondelles et écrous à travers le trou de fixation de la grille de protection radiateur puis dans le trous du support de fixation radiateur (Photo 4), avant de serrer.



- Une fois la grille de protection en place, le support inférieur doit être aligné avec le support inférieur de radiateur (Photo 5). Remettre le boulon d'origine puis serrer.
- Veiller à ce que la grille de protection soit correctement fixée puis serrer tous les boulons de façon équivalente.
