

Fitting Instructions for HLG0004SS Headlight Guard KTM 1050/1190 ADVENTURE 2015-



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In This Kit There Should Be


1x Headlight Guard Frame (SMW0052) 1x Polycarbonate Screen (PS0003) 4x M4 x 10mm Long Button Head Bolts 2x M4 x 25mm Long Button Head Bolts 6x M4 Rubber Well Nuts 2x M5 x 30mm Long Button Head Bolts 2x mounting spacers (S0909) 2x spacers (S0927) 2x M4 nuts

2x rubber grommets (RB50-20-00FG)

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 2.5mm A/F socket & wrench.
 - T30 Torx bit.
 - 2x 7mm spanners.
 - Small amount of super glue.






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FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

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- Locate the six M4 Rubber Well Nuts through the six holes in the polycarbonate screen from the front as shown in picture 1 and below.
- Locate the headlight guard frame onto the screen as shown in picture 2. The rubber flange on the well nuts should now sit between the polycarbonate screen and metal frame, as shown below left.





- Fit the four M4 x 10mm button head bolts through the four lower holes in the metal frame and tighten into the rubber well nuts, as shown above right. Ensure they are all tightened sufficiently that the rubber expands and holds the screen securely in place (the thread of the bolt should just start to protrude).
- Fit the two M4 x 25mm button head bolts through the two upper holes in the metal frame and tighten into the rubber well nuts, as shown in picture 3. Ensure they are all tightened sufficiently that the rubber expands and holds the screen securely in place (the thread of the bolt should protrude approximately 10mm).
- Fit the two nuts over the exposed thread of the two top bolts as shown in picture 3.
- Glue the two rubber grommets into the two threaded spacers (they fit into the non-threaded end).
- Fit the two threaded spacers with the grommets over the exposed end of the two top bolts as shown in picture 3.
- The assembly is now ready for mounting to the motorcycle.
- On the bike, remove the two Torx bolts from the front side panels as arrowed in the top picture.
- Place the two stepped spacers into the now vacant holes (the smaller spigot should fit snuggly into the panel hole).

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- Offer the assembly into position and secure using the two M5 bolts, adjust the two top spacers
 so the rubber grommets just contact the headlight to prevent movement of the assembly and
 lock into position using the two lock-nuts.
- Check that the headlight guard is correctly mounted and that there is clearance between the screen and headlight, before fully tightening all the bolts.

1x Cadre de protection feux (SMW0052)

1x Ecran Polycarbonate (PS0003)

4x M4 x 10mm Boulons

2x M4 x 25mm Boulons 6x M4 Ecrous caoutchouc

2x M5 x 30mm Boulons

2x Entretoises (S0909)

2x Entretoises (S0927)

2x M4 Ecrous

2x Rondelles de caoutchouc (RB50-20-00FG)

OUTILS REQUIS

- Jeu de clés à douille 2.5mmet.
 - Clé T30.
 - Pinces 2x 7mm.
 - Un peu de super glue.






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NOTICE DE MONTAGE

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- Placer les 6 écrous M4 à travers les 6 trous dans l'écran de polycarbonate depuis l'avant, voir photo 1 et dessous.
- Placer le cadre de protection feu sur l'écran, voir photo 2. La bride en caoutchouc sur les écrous doit se placer entre l'écran polycarbonate et le cadre métal, comme ci-dessous à gauche.





- Insérer les 4 boulons M4 x 10mm dans les 4 trous inférieurs dans le cadre métal et serrer les écrous, voir au dessus à droite. Vérifier qu'ils soient tous suffisamment serrés de façon à ce que le caoutchouc se dilate et maintienne l'écran en toute sécurité (le filetage du boulon devrait commencer à dépasser).
- Insérer les 2 boulons M4 x 25mm dans les 2 trous supérieurs du cadre métak et serrer les écrous, voir photo 3. Vérifier qu'ils soient tous suffisamment serrés de façon à ce que le caoutchouc se dilate et maintienne l'écran en toute sécurité (le filetage du boulon doit dépasser de 10mm).
- Insérer les 2 écrous sur le filetage des 2 boulons, voir photo 3.
- Coller les 2 rondelles en caoutchouc dans les 2 entretoises filetées (Elles se placent dans l'extrémité non filetée).
- Insérer les 2 entretoises avec rondelles sur l'extrémité des 2 boulons supérieurs, voir photo
 3.
- L'ensemble est maintenant prêt à être monté sur la moto.
- Sur la moto, enlever les 2 boulons Torx des panneaux avant, voir photo du dessus.



- Placer les 2 entretoises crantées dans les trous qui sont maintenant libres (the le plus petit ergot doit être bien ajusté dans le trou du panneau).
- Monter l'ensemble en position et fixer à l'aide des 2 boulons M5, ajuster les 2 entretoises supérieures de façon à ce que les rondelles de caoutchouc entrent en contact avec le phare pour éviter que l'ensemble bouge, puis bloquer la position en utilisant les 2 écrous de blocage.
- Vérifier que la protection feux soit correctement montée et qu'il y ait un espace entre l'écran et le feu, avant de serrer complètement tous les boulons.
